

## How to make a a token board in PowerPoint


I. When you are in PowerPoint, use the shape tool to draw a rectangle in your paper. This will serve as the token board base.




2. Use the outline took to make a boarder around the rectangle. Play around with the thickness tool to make the line as bold as you want. Use the fill tool to fill the box in white so we can layer boxes, images and text in.




3. Use the table tool to add a row of 5x1 to make a row for tokens



4. Make sure to add boarders to the boxes and fill them in white so we can add images. We will also resize them to fit along the bottom of the rectangle.




5. Use text box to add text to the token board.




6. Use the shape tool and text box to make an area for a "I am working for" image




## 8. Add images to make tokens and I am working for cards
